Where the baby develops during pregnancy.	Carries egg cells from the ovaries to the uterus.	A muscular tube that leads from the cervix to the outside of the body.
A ring of muscle at the lower end of the uterus. This keeps the baby in place during pregnancy.	Contains hundreds of undeveloped egg cells. Every month, an egg cell matures and is released.	A blood-rich layer of tissue in which an embryo implants. This lining is lost every month during menstruation.
