Trump \_\_\_\_\_ (**begin**) his career at the family real estate company, Elizabeth Trump and Son, which focused on middle-class rental housing in New York.

He \_\_\_\_\_ (**give**) control of the company in 1971 and one of his first acts was to rename it The Trump Organization.

The Trump Organization \_\_\_\_\_ (**invest**) in: real estate development, the stock market and property management. It owns a New York television production company that \_\_\_\_\_ (**produce**) the reality television program, The Apprentice.

The Trump Organization also \_\_\_\_\_ (**have**) global investments in real estate, construction, entertainment, food & beverages, airlines and beauty competitions.

In October 2016, the Economist magazine \_\_\_\_\_ (**conclude**) that Trump's "business career performance from 1985 to 2016" \_\_\_\_\_ (**be**) mediocre compared with the stock market and property in New York". A subsequent analysis by The Washington Post \_\_\_\_\_ (**report**) that "Trump \_\_\_\_\_ (**be**) a mix of arrogance, business failures, and real success".
