Gozo, Malta (3 hours)



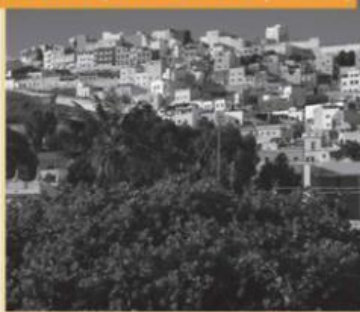

Marrakech, Morocco (4 hours)



Marrakech is a city with a lot of history. The temperature is 23°C in November, which is the perfect weather to enjoy the world-famous Medina market. This is a 19-kilometre street market where you can buy any kind of food, furniture, art and jewellery made by local people. It's easy to find cheap accommodation in Marrakech.
