EXAMINER'S QUESTIONS	
A. Personal information	What is your full name? Where/when were you born? Are you 20 years old? What are your hobbies? What do you do after school? Do you have a sister? What does she do (occupation)?
B. Work and study	What's your major? What does a graphic designer/engineer do? Are you in the 1 st semester? Do you have a part time job after school? What activities do you have to do at school/work?
C. Family and Home	How many members are there in your family? Are you the youngest person in your family? Which is your favorite room? Why? What does your family do together?
D. Past experiences	Where were you on your last vacation? What did you do yesterday? Did you eat sushi? Did you learn English in high school?
E. Future	Are you going to do anything special this weekend? How will you use English in the future? Where are you going to go after this class? What will education be like in the future? How do you see yourself in 5 years? Do you have any plans for the future/for the weekend?
