- 3 Cycle along the west bank of the Nile towards Edfu.
- 4 Cycle from Edfu to Aswan.
- 5 Cycle through Aswan to the High Dam. Visit the temples of Philae. Sail to Kom Ombo.
- 6 Cycle from Kom Ombo to Esna.
- 7 Cycle to Luxor through the Valley of the Kings, on the west bank of the Nile, opposite Luxor town. Visit the Theban Necropolis (royal tombs).
- 8 Rest day, with optional sightseeing tour (highly recommended).
- 9 Fly to London (pm departure), via Cairo.
