

## Noun Phrases

Some Wh-words are “where”, “when”, ‘what’ and ‘how’.

Wh-clauses always start with these words.

Examples: Can you suggest **where to go for dinner?**

Sally did not know **when to set off.**

He will know **what to say later.**

Henry realizes **how to solve the puzzle.**
