

## What's Missing? Fix it!

**What is a sentence?**  
sentence = 1 complete idea

**A complete idea has 2 parts:**  
someone/something + do/be

### What is a fragment?

**A fragment is a broken piece of something.**

**A broken sentence fragment is missing someone/something  
OR**

**A broken sentence fragment is missing do/be.**

**Example:** My kind, funny friend.

**What's missing?** do or be

**Fix it!** My kind, funny friend texted me.

### What is a fragment?
