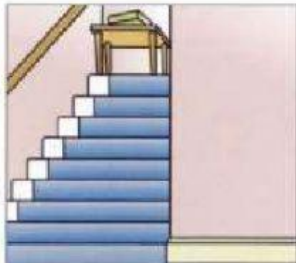

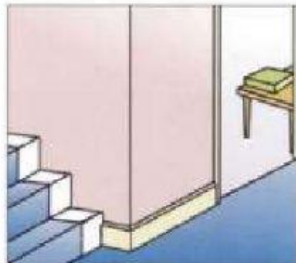

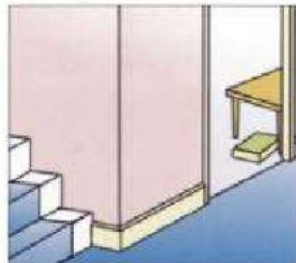

GRAPHIC ORGANIZER: SPIDER MAP

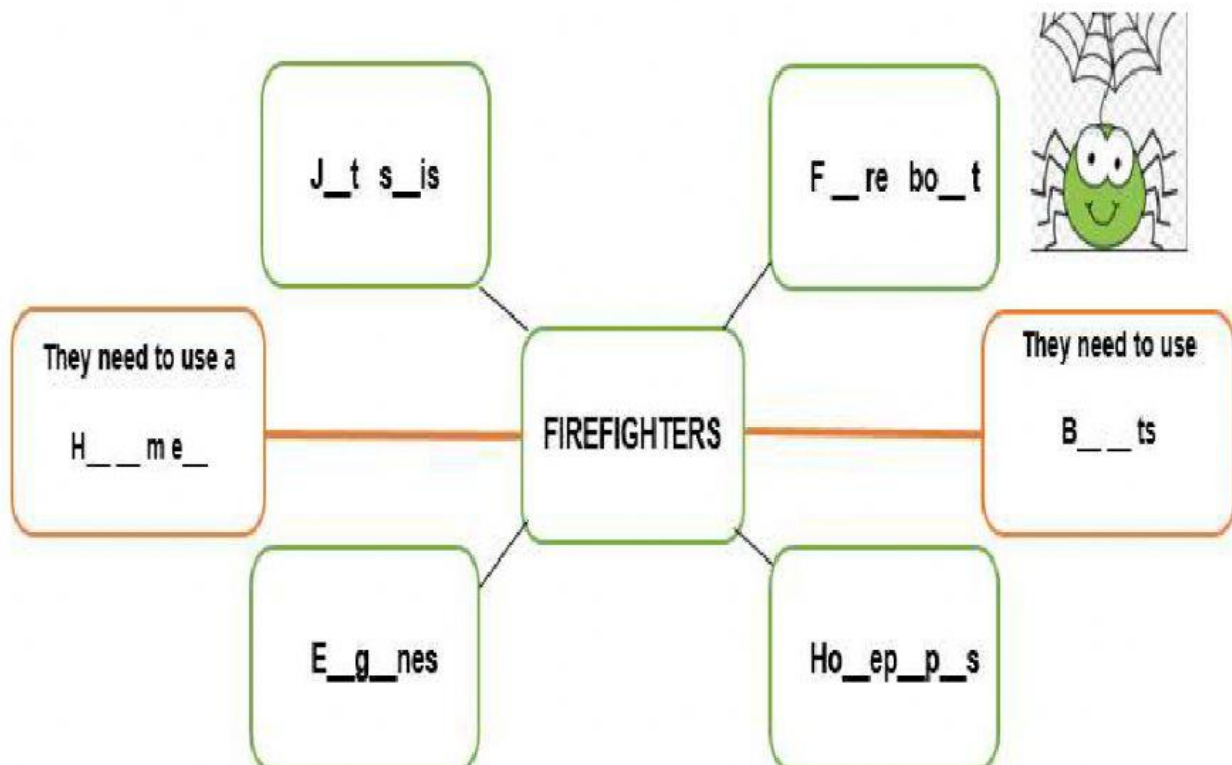
Read a “**Busy days for firefighters**” on page 9. What did firefighters used to put out fires? Write the information asked in each part about nouns.
