From what we know, there are eight (1) stars / **planets** in our (2) solar / lunar system.

- Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune are called the (3) outer / inner planets because they're farther from the sun. Mercury, Venus, Earth, and Mars are known as the (4) inner / outer planets because they're closer to the sun.
- There are rocky objects that orbit the sun, called (5) comets / asteroids. They're not big enough to be called planets or dwarf planets. There are also frozen objects that orbit the sun, called (6) comets / asteroids.
- All the objects in our solar system are attracted by the sun's (7) ellipse / gravity.
- A planet doesn't orbit in a round circle, but in a slightly stretched-out circle called an (8) ellipse / eclipse.
