Coral Reefs

The Great Barrier Reef is the world's largest coral reef system.

It is one of the natural wonders in the world. It is larger than the Great Wall of China and the only living thing on Earth visible from space.

The reef is located in the Coral Sea in Australia. The Great Barrier Reef is in tropical waters where temperature is warm in summer and winter.

A coral reef is a cozy and safe place to live for many animals like the jellyfish family, Whales and dolphins. More than 1500 fish species live on the reef such as clownfish and also turtle, blue ringed octopus and about 5000 species of mollusk as well as 400 different corals.
