

Difference Between “A” and “An”

We use the “ ” only if the word begins with a consonant.

We use the “ ” only if the word begins with a vowel.

EXCEPTIONS

If the word begins with the letter “h” and the “h” makes no sound you need to put the letter “ ”

If the word begins with the letter “h” and the “h” make a sound you need to put the letters “ ”

If the word begins with the letter “u” and the “u” make the sound “you”, you need to put the letters “ ”

If the word begins with the letter “u” and the “u” makes a sound different like “um” you need to put the letter “ ”
