DESCRIBING OBJECTS

DESCRIBING OBJECTS

SIZE

How big is it?

Tiny, small, medium-sized, big, enormous

SHAPE

What shape is it?

Square, round, oval, triangular...



OPINIONS

Heavy, light, old, new...



COLOR

What color is it?

Red, blue, white...

MATERIAL

What is it made of?

Wood, plastic, leather, glass...



PURPOSE

What is it used for?

It is used for playing, walking, sleeping, eating...

It is a nice, big, new, round, colorful ball. It is made of rubber or leather.

It is used for playing football.

ADJECTIVES ORDER

OPINION → SIZE → AGE → SHAPE → COLOR → MATERIAL → PURPOSE

*** It is very unusual to have more than three adjective in front of a noun.

EXAMPLES



This is the London Eye. It is an enormous Ferris Wheel by the river Thames in London. It is 135 meters high. It is huge! It is very heavy because it is made of steel. It has a round shape and fluorescent tubes. At night, these tubes illuminate London with different colours.



This is an iPad. It's medium-sized and has rectangle shape. It is made of plastic, glass and metal and many other smaller parts. It has a touch screen and an operating system that runs apps. It is very useful because you can study and play games with it.



This is an egg. It is small and has an oval shape. It can be white or light brown. It is very healthy, and you can make delicious omelets for dinner.

TOPIC: ADJECTIVES ORDER

What is the correct order of adjectives? When you are going to use a number of different adjectives to describe a noun it is important to be able to put the adjectives in the correct order.

In this lesson, we will be looking at the best way to order your adjectives which will not only allow your sentences to flow much more easily but will also give you the impression of being a native English speaker.

Order of Adjectives

Basic types of adjectives and the correct order for using them.

EXAMPLES OF SENTENCES *(It is not common to use more than 3 adjectives in a sentence)*

- It is a small yellow wooden chair.
- Tana is an attractive tall Costa Rican woman.
- Peter is a smart tall Japanese boy.
- It is a fragile white Chinese vase.
- It is an expensive modern Korean train.
- It's a small rectangular wooden box.
- They are small black French cups.
- These are modern fast American computers.
- They are friendly tall Brazilian girls.
