

CONDITIONAL SENTENCES - IF CLAUSES, TYPE 1

Watch the following video carefully:



Now read the sentence: ***If** we **play** well, we **will win** the game.*

☞ This sentence has **two parts** and it expresses something that **may possibly happen**:

- 1 – If we play well,... ☞ starts with “**IF**” and express a **condition**.
- 2 - ...we will win the game. ☞ expresses the **consequence** of the if-clause.

Main rules:



IF + **PRESENT SIMPLE** + **FUTURE**



FUTURE + IF + **PRESENT SIMPLE**

will / won't + main verb
