We/you/they	Are (not) dancing now.

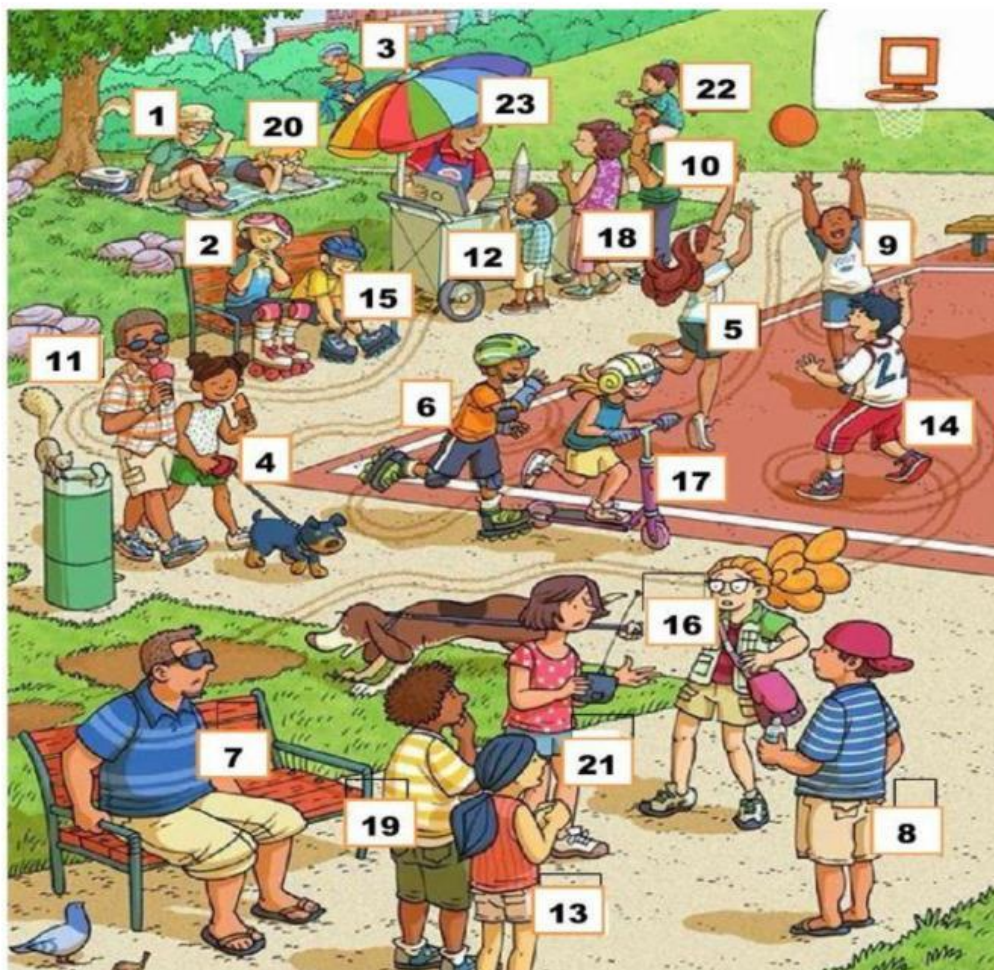
Yes/no questions
