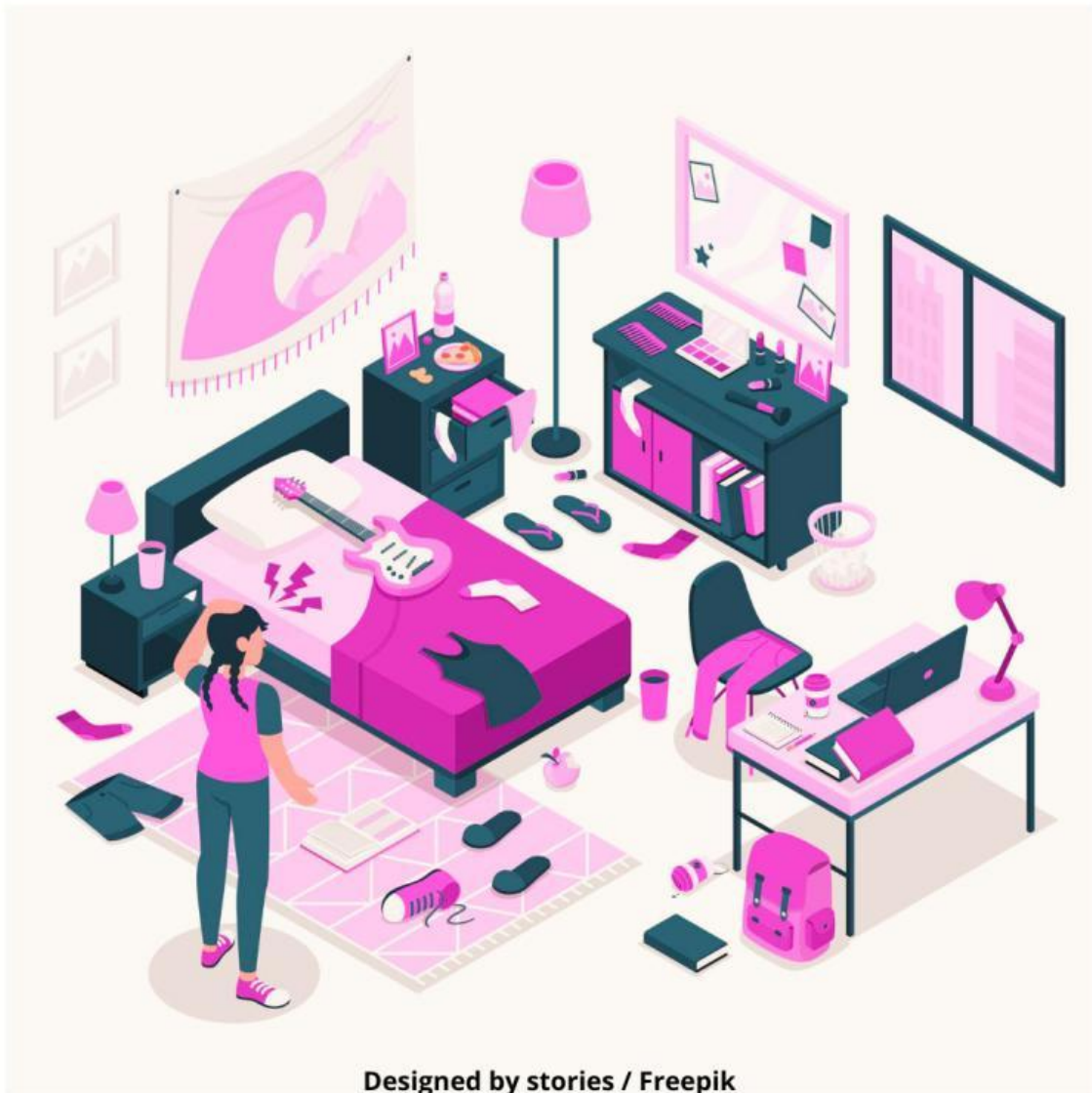
SINGULAR
