When 14-year-old Carla Engstrom had a holiday in Ethiopia, she met some children from a village school. They said they had no fresh water and walked two kilometres every day to get it. After she made a TV programme about her project, people began to send money to her JustGiving page on the Internet. 'We finished the first project last year, and the school now has fresh water', says Carla, 'and now I want to help as many people as possible.'

He has travelled all over Africa, India and Thailand making films about elephants. He has had several frightening experiences with dangerous criminals because of his documentaries, but he is going to continue. 'It is shocking that people kill elephants for their ivory; if I can help to stop it, I will.'
