


# Immune System Assessment Sheet




Put the numbers 1–6 in the circles to show the order in which your immune system works.




**A** A white blood cell starts to surround a bacterium or virus.




**B** An antibody recognizes a bacterium or virus and sticks to it.




**C** The white blood cell completely surrounds the bacterium or virus and eats it.



**D** Bacteria or viruses, enter your body.



**E** The bacterium or virus is destroyed, so the risk of disease is reduced.



**F** Your body makes special chemicals, called antibodies. These are released into the bloodstream.
