Water administration in practice

We are committed to ensuring that the water resources we manage and the savings we achieve by reducing freshwater withdrawals translate to additional water availability in socially equitable, environmentally sustainable, and economically beneficial ways.

In the third quarter of 2021, we undertook a qualitative assessment of available information to create a heatmap of water quality risks to assist in prioritizing interventions for prevention, management and mitigation of current impacts and risks. The results of this study formed the basis of our water quality initiative in 2022.

In 2022, we continued to work with our stakeholders to minimize risk while unlocking opportunities in a changing world. We strengthened our commitment to our Sustainable Mining Plan through the inclusion of our target to reduce the abstraction of fresh water in water-scarce areas by 50% by 2030.

By the end of 2022, we compiled a Group-wide database of our water stewardship activities. Nearly half of all projects provide access to water to the communities around our operations. This was acquired predominantly through supporting infrastructure for water supply, working closely with regulators, and local and national government.

Our SMP target implied making a strong contribution to returning fresh water to the catchments within which we operate, and we continue to increase our investments in improving water quality for communities and the environment.
