FORM	USE	FREQUENCY ADV
(+)S + V(s/es)+ O <i>She goes to school.</i>	- Used to describe repeated or regular actions <i>Ex: I take the train to the office</i> - <i>John sleeps eight hours every night during the week.</i>	Always, constantly
(-)S + do/does + not + V+ O <i>She does not go to school.</i>	<i>Ex: I take the train to the office</i> - <i>John sleeps eight hours every night during the week.</i>	Usually, frequently
(?) (Wh-) do/does +S + V+ O <i>When does she go to school?</i>	- Used to describe habits <i>Ex: I get up early every day</i> - <i>Carol doesn't brush her teeth twice a day.</i> - <i>Do they travel to their country every weekend?</i>	Often, occasionally
Do/does +S + V+ O? <i>Yes, S+ do/does</i> <i>No, S+ do/does + not</i> <i>Does she go to school?</i> <i>Yes, she does</i> <i>No, she doesn't</i>	- Used to describe truths <i>Ex: It rains a lot in winter</i> - <i>The Sun doesn't rise in the South</i>	Sometimes
she/he/it + V (s,es) I/you/we/they + V Do not => don't Does not => doesn't	- Used to describe facts <i>Ex: The president of the USA lives in The White House</i> - <i>A dog has four legs.</i>	Everyday/week/month
