Cách dùng	Dùng để diễn tả rằng một việc gì đó là không thể (ở thời điểm đang nói).	Dùng nói về khả năng xảy ra trong tương lai của một việc nhưng chưa chắc chắn.	Dùng để nói về khả năng ở hiện tại và tương lai. Might not là thể phủ định.	Dùng để diễn tả kết luận / suy luận chắc chắn của người nói về một vấn đề gì đó.

Ví dụ	Helen cannot be sick because I saw her at school this morning. (Helen không thể đang bệnh được vì tôi đã thấy cô ấy ở trường sáng nay.)	Helen could be at the library. (Helen có thể ở thư viện.)	I might not go to the party. (Tôi có thể không đến buổi tiệc.)	Omar got 10/10 in the exam. He must be very happy! (Omar đạt được 10/10 trong bài kiểm tra. Anh ấy chắc chắn rất vui.)

MADE OF	MADE FROM
chỉ chất liệu được dùng để tạo ra cái gì đó và khi hoàn thành, chất liệu đó không bị biến đổi về dạng.	chỉ chất liệu được dùng tạo ra cái gì đó và khi hoàn thành, chất liệu đó bị biến đổi về dạng.
Vd: This shirt is made of cotton. (Chiếc áo này được làm từ chất liệu cotton.)	Vd: Paper is made from trees. (Giấy được làm từ cây.)






