Present continuous - actions happening at the moment of speaking, future arrangements

Present perfect simple - from a time in the past up to the moment of speaking, experiences, recent completed actions

Present perfect continuous - a single activity that started in the past and is still in progress

Past simple - completed past actions

Past continuous - actions in progress at a point of time in the past

Past perfect simple - an action that happened before another action in the past

Will - predictions based on opinions, spontaneous decisions, promises

Be going to - predictions based on evidence, future plans, intentions
