We use the _____¹ to talk about repeated or permanent things:

I **wake up** every morning at 8 o'clock.

Where **do you live**?

We use the _____² to talk about things that are happening now or around this time:

I **'m learning** English at the moment.

He **isn't working** right now. He's on vacation.

We use the _____³ to talk about plans and future arrangements:

I **'m going** to the movies tonight.

Remember that some verbs are NEVER used with the _____⁴. These are called state verbs, e.g. love, like, know, need, want, hate, understand, etc.

I **like** her very much. (NOT ~~I'm liking~~ her.)
