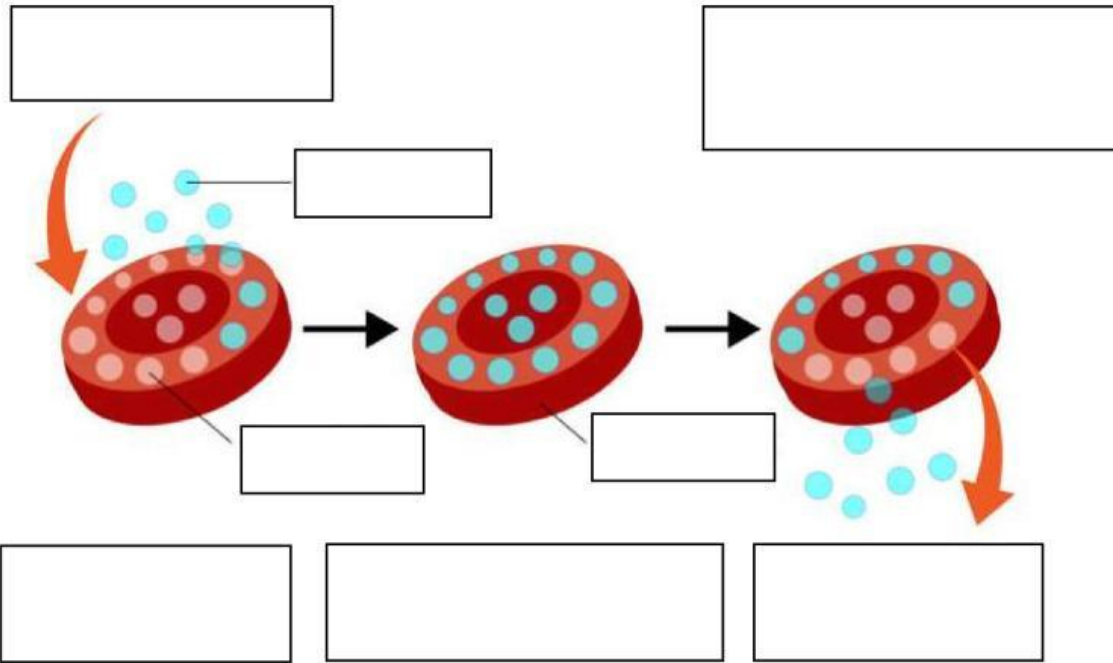


Haemoglobin
