QUESTION WORDS	USE
WHAT	- Used to ask objects, animals, colors, things, events,.... <i>what is your favorite color?</i>
WHEN / WHAT TIME	- Used to ask time <i>When do you wake up?</i> <i>What time is it?</i>
WHERE	- Used to ask address, direction, ... <i>Where is your hometown</i>
WHO	- Used to ask people <i>Who is your father?</i>
WHOSE	- Used to ask about possession <i>Whose book is this?</i>
HOW OFTEN	- Used to ask frequency of events or actions... <i>How often do you go to work?</i>
HOW	- Used to ask the characteristics, maners, means, ... of sth <i>How do you find out the answer for this difficult task?</i> <i>How is your new job going?</i> <i>How do you go to school? I go to school by bus.</i>
HOW LONG	- Used to ask the period of time that sth takes. <i>How long does it take you to do this assignment?</i>
HOW MANY	- Used to ask the quantity of countable nouns. <i>How many people are there in your family?</i>
HOW MUCH	- Used to ask the quantity of uncountable nouns/ price of sth <i>How much water do we have?</i> <i>How much does this dress cost?</i>
WHY	- Used to ask reasons or causes. <i>Why are you so late?</i>
