## 5-Celebrating the Sun (12p)

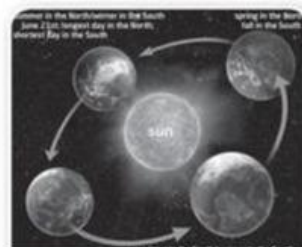
