NATURAL DISASTERS

Natural disasters can be extremely destructive and unpredictable. Some of the most common natural disasters include 1., which occur when the earth's crust shakes and can cause widespread damage to buildings and infrastructure. 2. are violent rotating columns of air that can destroy everything in their path. 3. are massive storms that form over the ocean and can bring heavy rain, high winds, and storm surges that flood coastal areas. 4. occur when bodies of water overflow their banks, and can cause damage to homes, businesses, and transportation systems. 5. are large fires that can spread quickly through forests, grasslands, and other areas, destroying homes and natural habitats. 6. occur when large masses of rock, earth, or debris move downhill, and can cause damage to roads, buildings, and homes. 7. are giant waves that can be triggered by earthquakes or volcanic eruptions, and can cause widespread destruction along coastlines. 8. eruptions occur when molten rock, ash, and gas are released from a volcano, and can cause damage to homes, agriculture, and transportation systems. 9. are prolonged periods of dry weather that can cause crop failures, water shortages, and other economic and environmental impacts. 10. are severe winter storms that can bring heavy snow, strong winds, and low visibility, making travel and other activities hazardous.
