Used to describe actions, events, situations,... already happened and finished in the past.

AFFIRMATIVE	NEGATIVE
S+ was/ were + O....	S+ was/ were + not + O....
I/he/she/it + was We/you/they+ were	Was not= wasn't Were not = weren't
I was at my uncle's house yesterday. They were in Hanoi on their summer vacation last month.	I wasn't at home last Monday. We weren't happy because our team lost.
