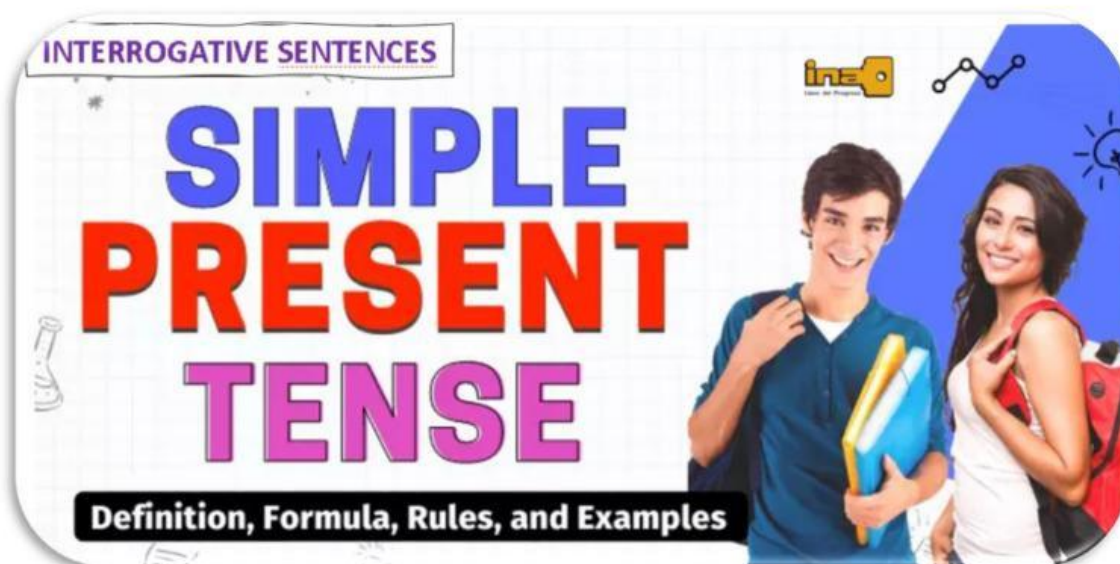


LEARNING UNIT # 1/Simple Present

Hello! In this lesson, you are going to learn how to use interrogative sentences in simple present tense.



Present Simple Interrogative form



Questions with :He, She, It...

DOES

He watch **television**?

DOES

She go to school?

The dog (It) play with Cindy?

In **Simple Present**, the action is simply mentioned and there is nothing being said about its completeness. It is used to talk about an action which happens on a regular basis.



Interrogative Statements / Questions

DO / DOES	SUBJECT	VERB	REST OF THE SENTENCE
Do	I	sleep	in the afternoon?
Do	you	sleep	in the afternoon?
Does	he	play	in the afternoon?
Does	John	play	in the afternoon?
Does	the boy	play	in the afternoon?
Does	she	play	in the afternoon?
Does	Anna	play	in the afternoon?
Does	the girl	play	in the afternoon?
Do	we	play	in the afternoon?
Do	you	play	in the afternoon?
Do	they	play	in the afternoon?
Do	the men	play	in the afternoon?

Notice how we use 'Do' for the subjects I, You, We, You and They and we use 'Does' for the subjects 'He' and 'She'. The verb form remains the same for all subjects.
Note: "Do" and "Does" are also called Auxiliary Verbs (or Helping Verbs).

WH-QUESTIONS (SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE)

Question words are also called *wh questions* because they include the letters 'W' and 'H'.

Question words	Meaning	Examples
who	person	Who's that? That's Nancy. Who drinks / has coffee? Marlon drinks coffee / Marlon has the PC. / knows the answer?
where	place	Where do you live? In Boston
why	reason	Why do you sleep early? Because I've got to get up early
when	time	When do you work? At 7:00
how	manner	How do you go? By car
what	object, idea or action	What do you do? I am an engineer
which	choice	Which one do you prefer? The red one.
what kind	description	What kind of music do you like? I like quiet songs
what time	time	What time do study English?
how many	quantity (countable)	How many pets do you have?
how much	amount, price (uncountable)	How much coffee do you want?
how long	duration, length	How long do you take to go to work?
how often	frequency	How often do you go to the gym? Twice a week.
how far	distance	How far do you live from here?
how old	age	How old are you? I'm 16.
how come	reason	How come you don't like to go to the beach?
