<p><b>The interrupted action</b></p> <p>When teacher <b>opened</b> the door, ...</p>	<p><b>An action in progress</b></p> <p>... all students <b>were running and talking</b> loudly.</p>
<p><b>The main action in the story</b></p> <p>Suddenly he <b>heard</b> a BANG noise .....</p>	<p><b>The background situation</b></p> <p>... when he <b>was riding</b> his horse in the forest.</p>

**When we use the PAST CONTINUOUS and the PAST SIMPLE together like this, we often use WHILE or WHEN**

It was snowing **when** I woke up this morning.

**While** I was walking home, I found a leather wallet.

**But we don't use WHILE for past simple.**

I was walking to work **when while** I saw Roger in his car.

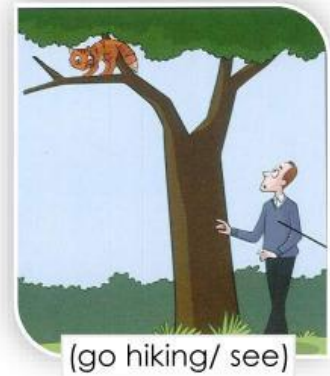
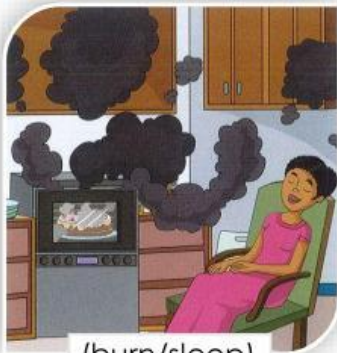
