He has pizza and carrots for lunch.

4. I have cereal for breakfast. / I have orange juice for breakfast.

I have cereal and orange juice for breakfast.

5. Tom and Sue have noodles for lunch. / Tom and Sue have peas for lunch.

They have noodles and peas for lunch.

6. Peter has biscuits for breakfast. / Peter has milk for breakfast.

Peter has biscuits and milk for breakfast.

7. Anna has chicken for dinner. / Anna has chips for dinner.

Anna has chicken and chips for dinner.
