1. 의미 : \_\_\_\_\_

2. 형태 : too + \_\_\_\_\_ + to \_\_\_\_\_

ex) My brother is too young to eat food by himself.

The man is too poor to buy the new car.


I was **too** tired **to walk** to school.

The problem is **too** difficult **to solve**.

\*\* [too ... to ~] = [so ... that + 주어 + can't [couldn't] ~]

ex) The students are **too** excited **to sit** still.

→ The students are **so** excited **that** they **can't** sit still.


