Stegosaurus

In Science class, Kevin was asked by his teacher, Puan Hamida to do a presentation on an interesting dinosaur. Kevin borrowed a book about dinosaurs from the library and started to read about his favourite, the stegosaurus. He wrote down some interesting facts about the stegosaurus and plans to share them with the class.



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- lived about 150 million years ago
 - the name 'stegosaurus' means 'roof lizard' in Greek
 - usually grew to a length of 6.5 metres but sometimes reached 9 metres
 - herbivore
 - ate plants like ferns, moss and fruits
 - had a row of triangular plates made of bones on its neck and back
 - had spikes on its tail to protect itself and to control its body temperature
