

Beitou Park



Beitou Park was built in 1913 and is one of Taipei's oldest parks. It is also special because it is Taiwan's first hot spring park. Beitou Park is near the Xinbeitou MRT station, so it is very easy for tourists to go there.



There are many old trees, fountains, a small waterfall, and a stream from Thermal Valley. Many kinds of birds also live in the trees and plants.

The Beitou Library and Beitou Hot Spring Museum are also in the park. Many tourists like to go to the park for a nice picnic, walk around, or sit and read a book.



It is open 24 hours, so many people like to exercise in the park early in the morning.
