Affirmative Form

I
He
She
It

We
You
They

To be verb
Was + crying
Present continuous form

were + driving

Interrogative Form

TO BE + SUBJECT + MAIN VERB_ING?

→ Examples:

Were they driving ?

Was I crying ?

GENERAL FORM

Subject + was / were + verb_ing



Negative Form

TO BE + SUBJECT + NOT + MAIN VERB_ING?

→ Examples:

I wasn't crying.

You weren't crying.

! Was not =
Wasn't
Were not =
Weren't
