

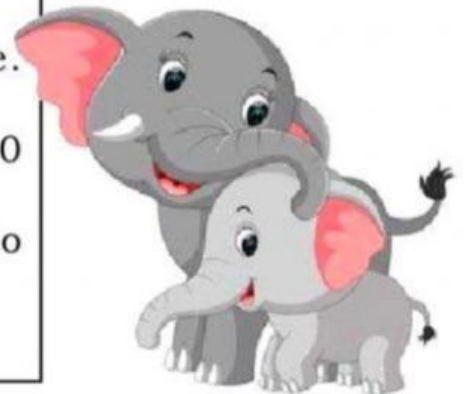

5. It's a bird. It's pink and beautiful. It lives near water in warm countries.

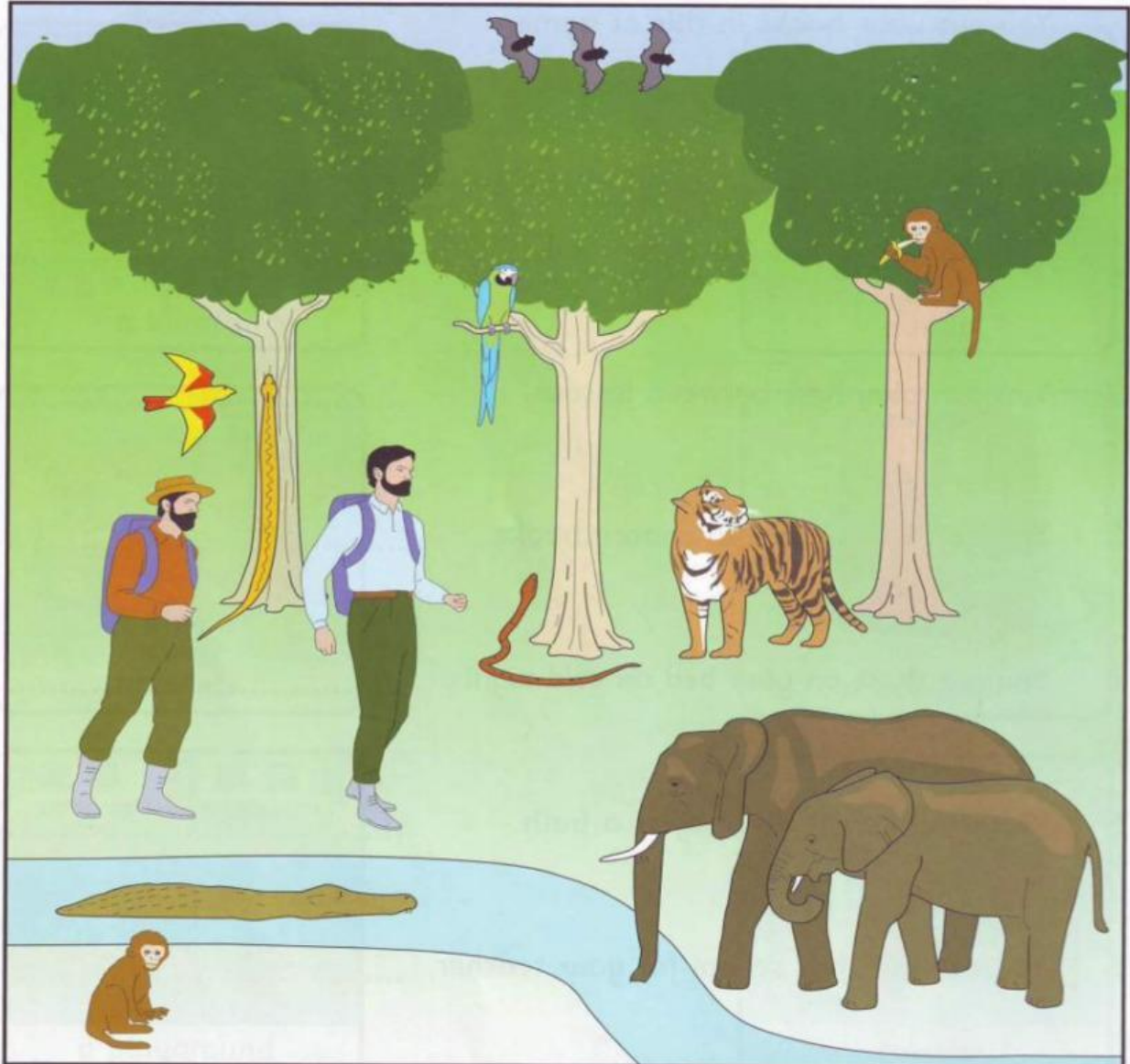
