Present simple versus present continuous

Present simple	I / You / We / They	go	swimming	every day. at the weekend. on Fridays.
	He / She	goes	climbing trampolining	
Present continuous	I'm / You're / We're / They're	going	diving	in this picture. now.
	He's / She's		abseiling
