Reading

An amazing place

St Kilda is an archipelago situated in the North Atlantic Ocean, off the north-west coast of Scotland. It consists of three main islands with a total area of 850 hectares. The main island, Hirta, has an area of 670 hectares. It is a beautiful green island with high mountains. A special feature of the island's landscape are the dangerous cliffs which are the highest ones in Great Britain.

For hundreds of years, St Kilda was one of the smallest and most remote inhabited islands in Europe. At one time, 180 people lived on the island, but by the beginning of the 20th century, there were less than 100. The people of St Kilda lived mainly on fish and seabird eggs, but they also kept some sheep and cows. Life on the island was very hard. The island had no doctor and the stormy seas around the island meant that it was often too dangerous for boats to land, so if people became ill, they often died. In the middle of the 19th century, the residents had a church and a daily school for the children, but there still wasn't a doctor. Moreover, everyday life on the island was becoming more and more difficult. That was why in 1930 the last 36 inhabitants left the island.

Today, there are no ordinary residents on the island, but scientists, volunteer workers and members of the military stay there during the whole year. Besides this, tourists often visit the place in the summer when the sea is calm enough for boats to land. There are some really interesting ruins on the island: three old churches and a few old houses of the people who once lived there. The island is also a nature reserve and thousands of seabirds and sheep live there.
