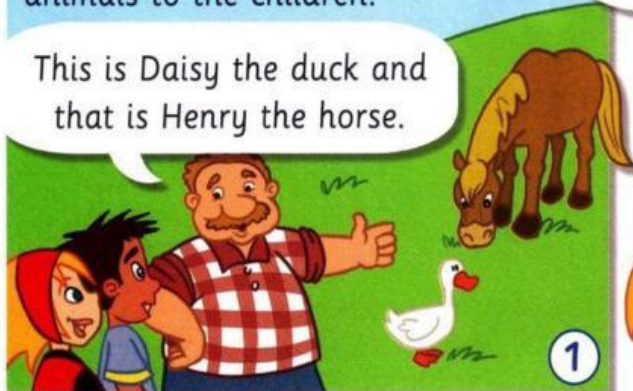

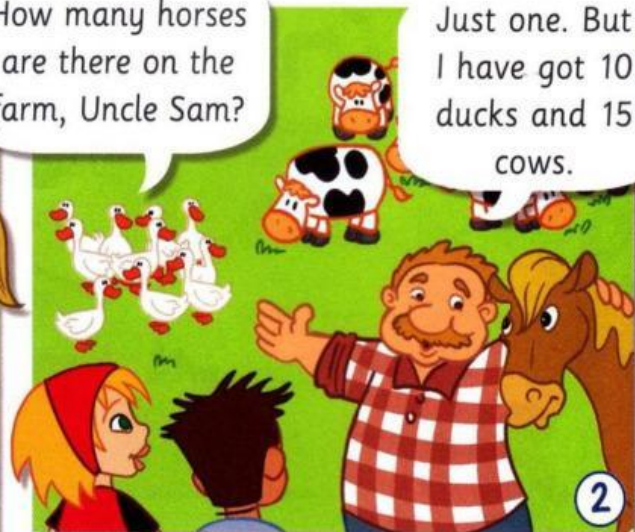
Greg and Anna are on Uncle Sam's farm. Uncle Sam is showing the animals to the children.

Just one. But I have got 10 ducks and 15 cows.



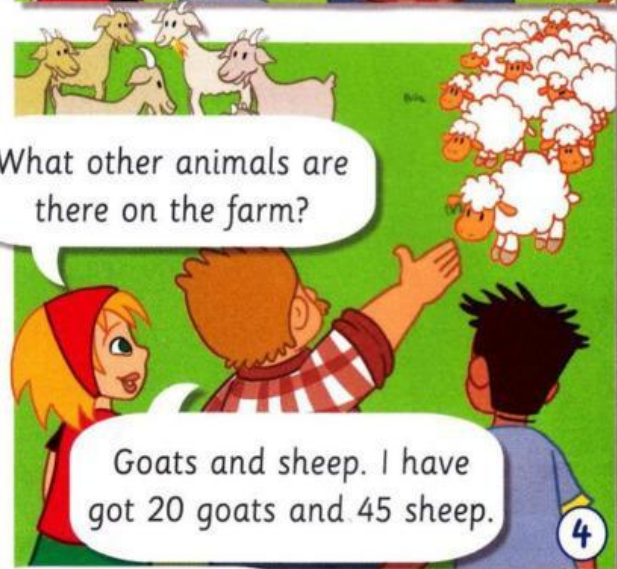
Do ducks eat tomatoes?

Of course. They love them!



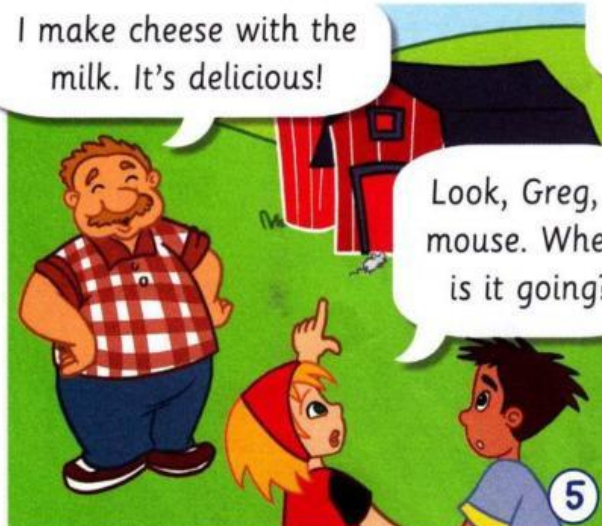
What other animals are there on the farm?

Goats and sheep. I have got 20 goats and 45 sheep.



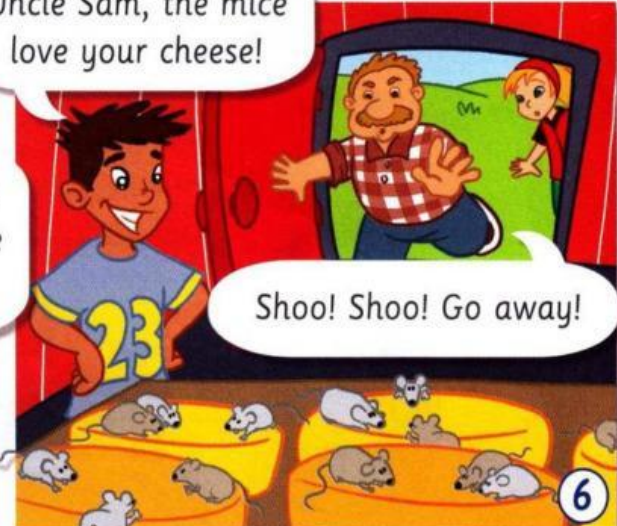
I make cheese with the milk. It's delicious!
