Multiplying Decimals

To Multiply decimals follow these simple steps:

Example: Multiply

$$3.4 \times 0.2 =$$

- Remove the decimal point. $34 \times 2 =$
- Multiply the numbers as normal. $34 \times 2 = 68$
- Count the number of digits behind the decimal point. 2 dp
- Place the decimal point in your answer to match the same amount of digits behind the decimal point you counted. Answer: 0.68
