#### WROCLAW ZOO

If you're looking for a great day out, why not try the zoo in Wrocław? It's a great place for the whole family, with something for everyone. If you don't mind scary animals, try the snake house, where they have pythons, black mambas and even an anaconda! For younger kids there is a mini-zoo with some cute, small animals we normally think of as pets. There is an open area with guinea pigs and rabbits, and, for a few zlotys, you can buy some food so that you can feed them yourself. If you are lucky, you might even be able to touch them. 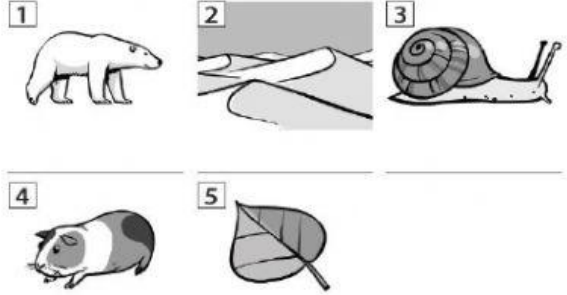
