- ❖ When giving the id for the Button, give it as "buttonQuestion1, buttonQuestion2 ...". Then the relevant button can be easily caught during coding.

- ❖ After designing in that way, let's start coding.
- ❖ When you click on a button with each question, let's set the image of Ruby robot to appear in the image we designed, and hear the answer according to the selected voice and language.
