Bangladesh

Bangladesh is one of the wettest countries on Earth. From November to May, it's quite dry, but from June until October, there is water everywhere. Children can't walk into town because there is a lot of water in the streets, and it is very deep.

At these times, children go on boats on the river. The boats stop at different places on the river and more children get on. There are lots of trees and wildlife near the river. The children like watching the birds and monkeys in the forest, but they aren't on the boats to enjoy nature. The boats are their school! Today, on one of the boats, there are 30 students having a lesson. They are on the library boat. It's a bigger boat than their usual classroom boat. It has hundreds of books, and it has computers as well. They have ICT on the library boat. They stay on the boat all morning.
