

ОТНОСИТЕЛЬНЫЕ МЕСТОИМЕНИЯ / НАРЕЧИЯ

Who — кто, который, которые. Употребляется с одушевленными существительными:

*The boy **who** is standing near the window is Robert.*
*The people **who** are waving me from the other side of the street are my friends.*

Whom — который, которые. Употребляется с одушевленными существительными в косвенных падежах:

*The boy **whom** I spoke to is my son.*
*That's the girl to **whom** I gave my book.*

Which — который, которая, которые. Употребляется с неодушевленными существительными:

*The book **which / that** I bought yesterday is on the shelf.*
*He asked me a question to **which** I didn't know the answer.*

Which — что, это. Относится ко всему предшествующему предложению. Перед таким **which** обычно ставится запятая:

*You help Peter, **which** is very kind of you.*
*You haven't fastened the belt, **which** is very dangerous for you.*

Whose — чей:

*Ann, **whose** son has won the first prize, is happy very much.*

When — когда (о времени):

*I remember the day **when** I met my husband.*

Where — где (о месте):

*The city **where** I was born is very huge.*

Why — почему (причина):

*That's the reason **why (that)** I didn't come yesterday.*

That используется:

1. В значении который / которые, когда относится к людям, вещам, времени, месту:

*The dress **that** you are wearing doesn't suit you.*

2. После прилагательных в превосходной степени:

*This is the most interesting book **that** I have ever read.*

3. После порядковых числительных:

*This is the first time **that** he has done his homework.*

4. После слов **all, any, only**:

*You should read all the books (**that**) your teacher recommended you.*

5. После слов, обозначающих промежутки времени (**the day / week / month / time** и т. д.):

*I remember that day (**that**) we got married.*

Относительное местоимение **that** употребляется только в придаточных ограничительных предложениях. Его также можно заменить на **who** (для людей) или **which** (для предметов).

Относительные местоимения **which, whom, that** могут опускаться, когда они выполняют функцию дополнения или обстоятельства в придаточных предложениях:

*Here is the book (**which / that**) you gave me.*
*The woman (**whom**) you see in the hall is my best friend.*



Запомните!

В описательных придаточных определительных предложениях заменить союзные слова **who, whom, which** словом **that** нельзя:
*We received a letter **which** contained some important information.*

That часто используется в разговорной речи, **who** и **which** более характерны для письменного английского:

(Разговорная речь) *Robert Burns is a Scottish poet **that** wrote a lot of wonderful poems and songs.*

(Письменный, официальный английский) *Robert Burns is a Scottish poet **who** wrote a lot of wonderful poems and songs.*
