



Hello! In this lesson, you are going to learn how to use **possessive adjectives** and apply them correctly.

In terms of possessive adjective definition, it's a word that clarifies ownership (who owns something). They can only be used before the noun they refer to.

It typically comes before a noun to express who or what owns the noun, such as in the phrases "my house" and "our study group."

PERSONAL PRONOUNS	POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES
I	MY
HE	HIS
SHE	HER
IT	ITS
YOU	YOUR
WE	OUR
THEY	THEIR

It is used to **express possession.**

Examples:

1. **Shakira** is a singer but **her** husband **is** a teacher.
2. **The teacher** is Peruvian and **his** wife is a famous doctor.
3. **My** sisters are lawyers and their best friends are pilots.
4. **You and I** are students, **our** parents are architects.


