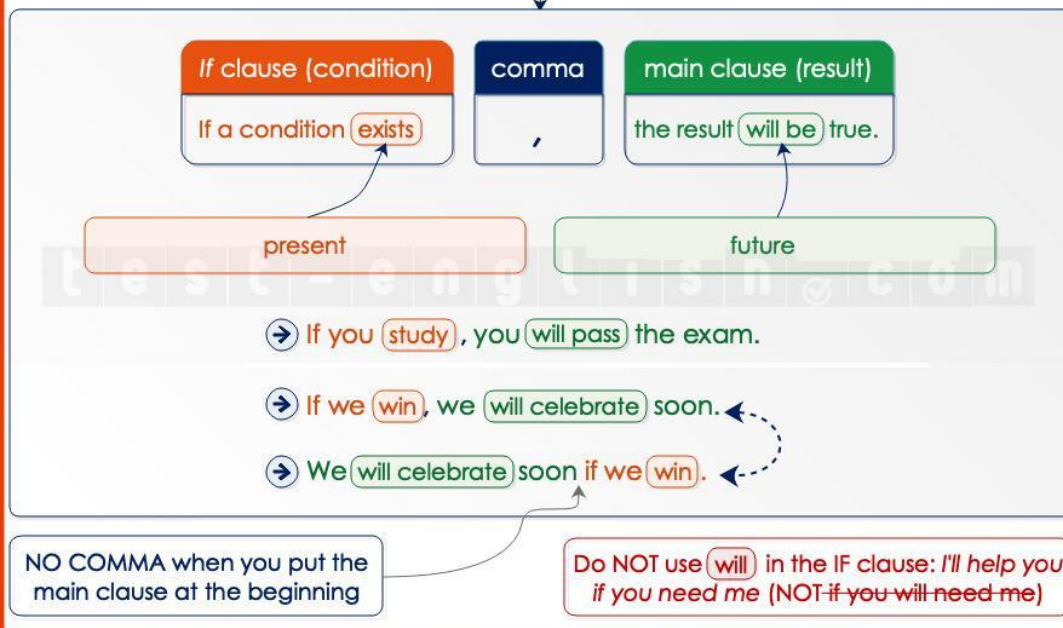


FIRST CONDITIONAL
