#### Present Simple

##### Form

Affirmative I/We/You/They/ **like** listening to jazz.  
He/She/It/Mary **likes** listening to jazz.

##### Negative

I/We/You/They/ **don't like** listening to jazz.  
He/She/It **doesn't like** listening to jazz.

##### Questions

**Does** he/she/it **like** playing games?  
**Yes**, he/she/it **does**. / **No**, he/she/it **doesn't**.  
**Do** we/you/they **like** listening to jazz?  
**Yes**, we/I/they **do**. /**No**, we/I/they **don't**.

##### Usage

We use the **Present Simple** to talk about general preferences (likes and dislikes).

Pete **enjoys** listening to rock.

Ann **doesn't like** classical music.

#### Spelling rules of adding **-s/es**

For most verbs, we add **-s**.

like → likes  
play → plays  
enjoy → enjoys  
listen → listens

For verbs ending in **-o, -s, -ch, -x, -sh, -z**, we add **-es**.

do → does  
watch → watches  
fix → fixes  
finish → finishes

For verbs ending in **consonant + y**, change **y** to **ies**.

fly → flies  
cry → cries  
worry → worries  
study → studies
