

# PAST PERFECT CONTINUOUS

## MIXED

Use the verbs in brackets to make the **Past Perfect Continuous** (this exercise includes positive, negative, Yes/No, or Wh-question form).

### Example:

How long \_\_\_\_\_ James \_\_\_\_\_ there before he got fired? **(to work)**

### Answer:

How long **had** James **been working** there before he got fired?
