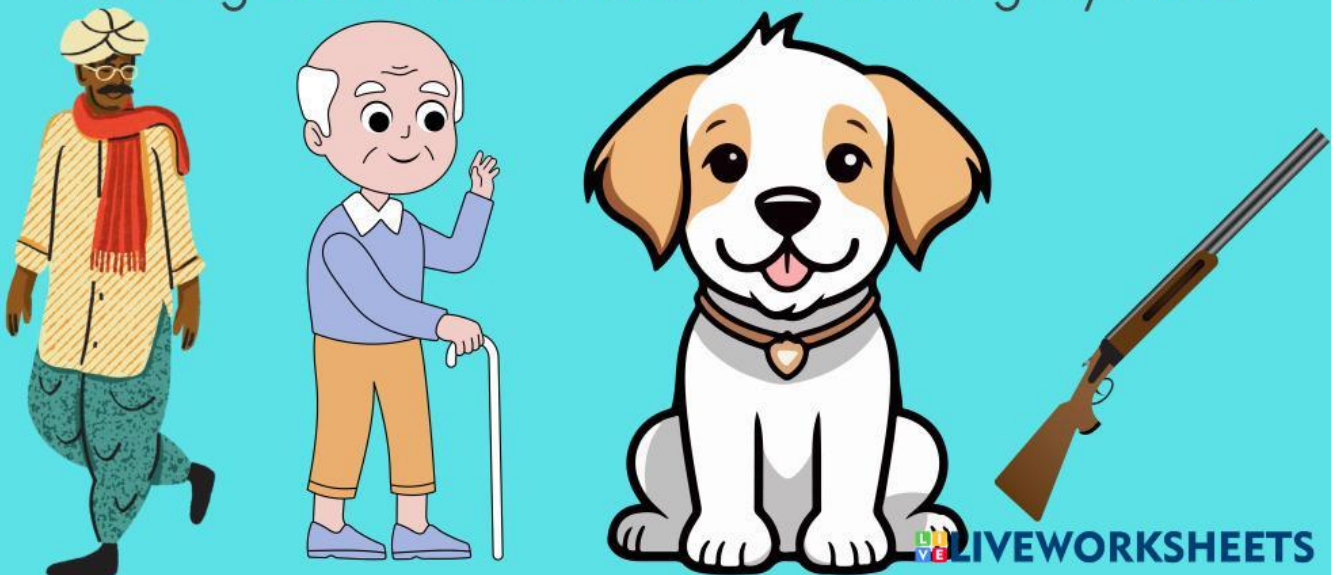


THE INDIAN
