

1. **The Grand Canyon** is found in the US in the state of Arizona.

Created over 6 million years ago by the Colorado River, the canyon is over 466 km long and has a depth of 1600 m.



2. **The Great Barrier Reef**, stretching over 2.300 km and covering an area of 348.000 km, is the largest coral reef on Earth, located in the coral sea of the northeast coast of Queensland, Australia. The reef contains 2,900 individual reefs and 900 islands.

3. **The Harbour of Rio de Janeiro** is a fascinating natural landscape where the ocean meets the shore. The giant statue of Christ named Christ the Redeemer is atop Mount Corcovado.

4. **Mount Everest**, at 8,480m Everest is the highest mountain in the world.

5. **Aurora Borealis**, also known as the northern lights, displays natural lights in the sky noticeable at night. They are occurring only in the northern hemisphere.

6. **Parícutin Volcano** in Mexico began its life as a fissure in a cornfield on February 20, 1943. After a year, it has grown to 336 m and now stands at 424 tall.

7. **Victoria Falls** in southern Africa is one of the most significant falls in the world. It is the largest sheet of falling water in the world.



