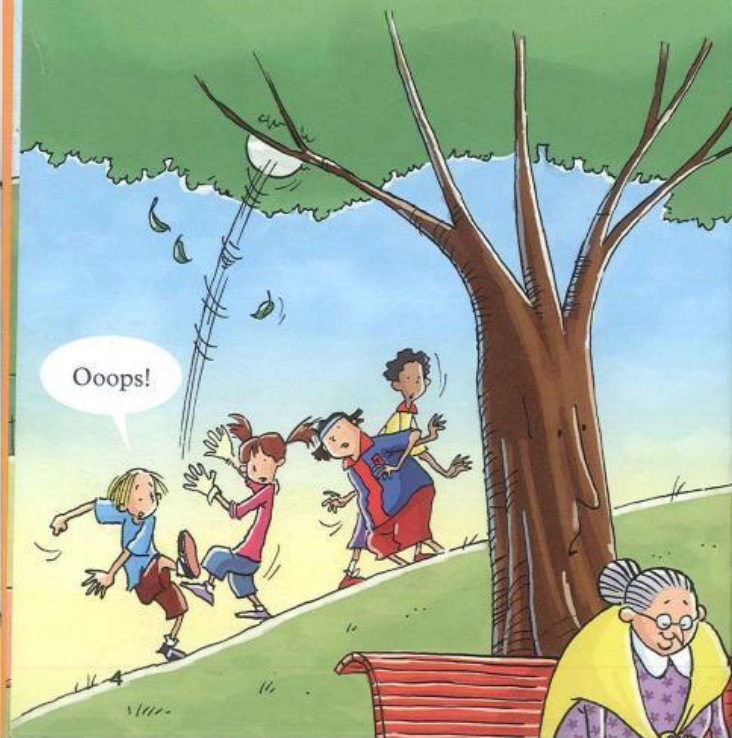
- 2 It's a beautiful day. There are some children playing in the park. They're playing basketball and football and riding bikes and skateboarding. Everyone is very happy.

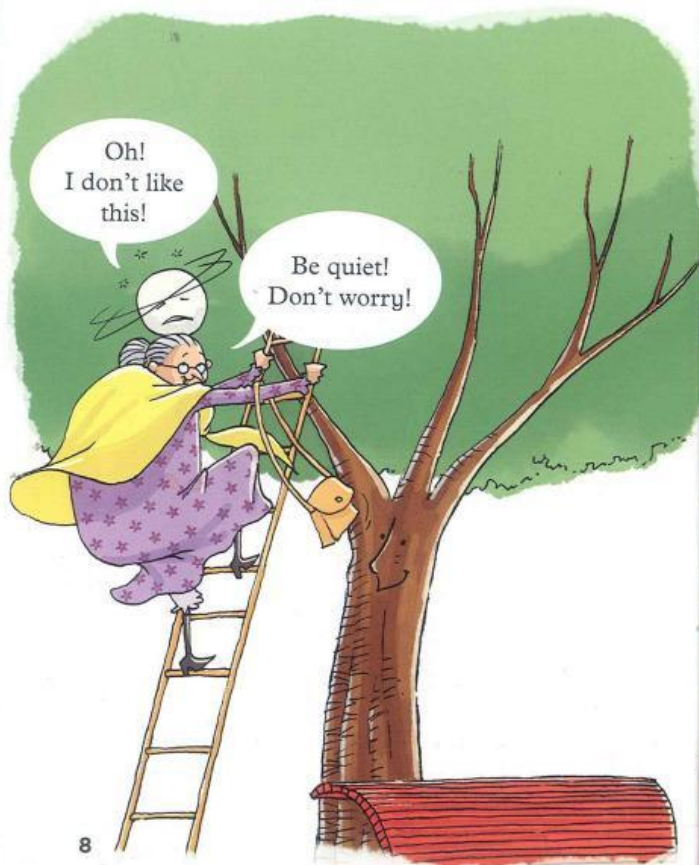

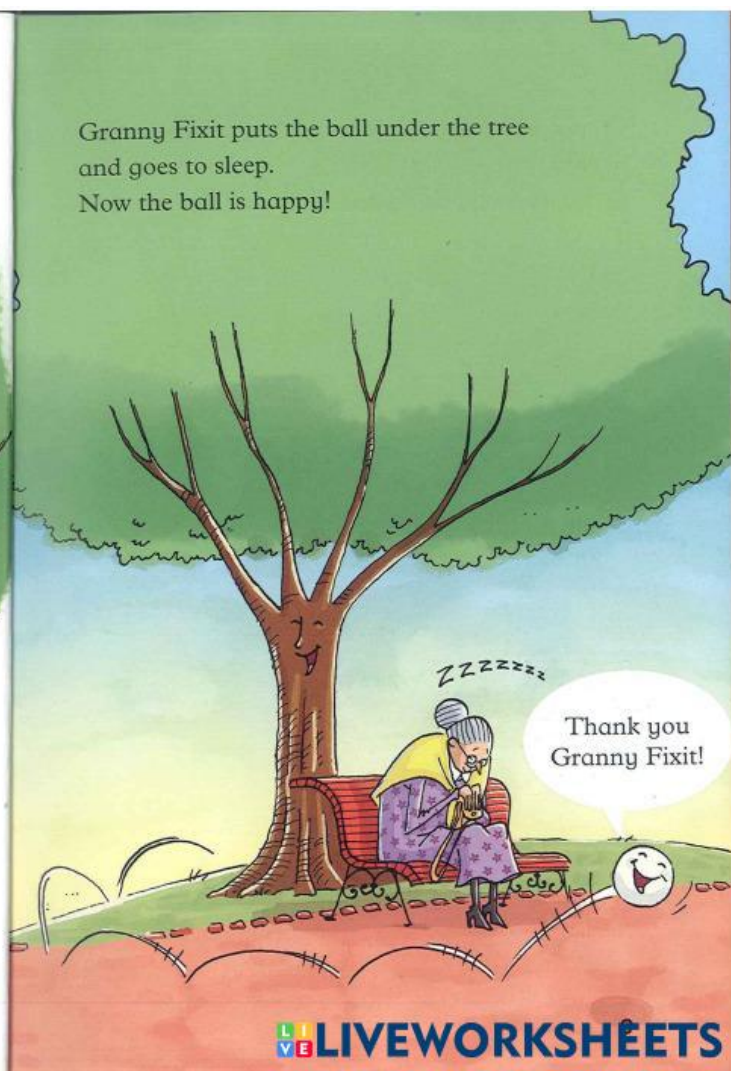
Granny Fixit wants to help the ball.

for me!

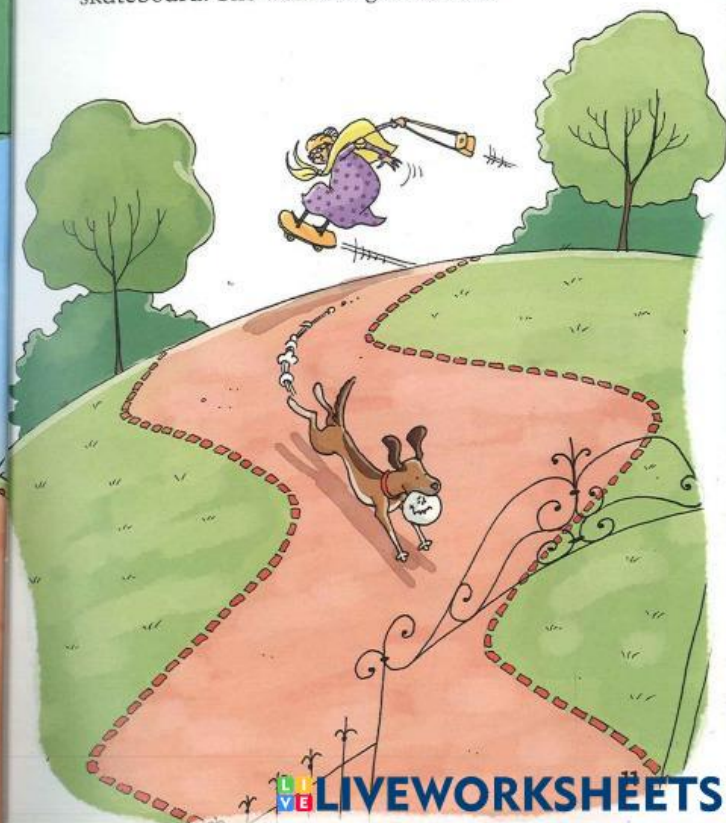

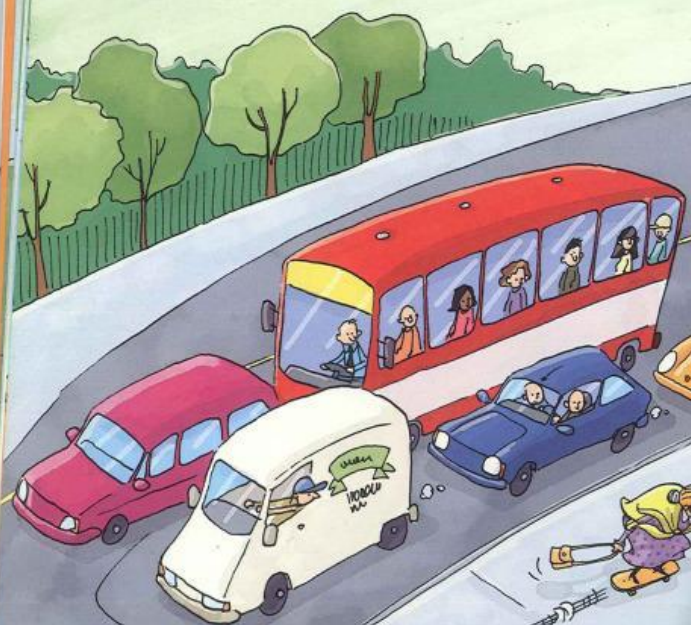
It's a skateboard! The dog goes away with the ball.
